The Knightdale-Wake Forest Alumnae Chapter will award one scholarship to a deserving, African-American student. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

The candidate must be a current, African-American high school senior, entering as a freshman at an accredited college, university, technical or community college with at least a 2.75 or unweighted equivalent grade point average (GPA). Awards are made on a competitive basis. Students must have an overall 2.75 GPA and must have maintained at least a 2.75 GPA throughout his/her senior year of high school. Candidate **must attend a high school in Knightdale-Wake Forest (KWF) Alumnae Chapter's Service Area (East Wake, Heritage, Knightdale, Millbrook, and Wakefield, Wake Forest-Rolesville).**

AWARD: The award recipient will receive **\$500.00** for the academic year for undergraduate study.

**SELECTION
CRITERIA:**

- * Satisfactory academic progress (**2.75 GPA** or above) – **Unweighted**
- * African-American Graduating High School Senior
- * Entering freshman or first year student (according to credit)
- * Must attend high school in KWF Alumnae service area
- * Completed 300-500 word essay
- * Community Service Involvement
- * Accepted for admission to an accredited college, university, technical or community college (not on a conditional basis) for the upcoming semester (Fall 2012)
- * One (1) sealed letter of recommendation; must be from a school Official (i.e., principal, teacher, school counselor, etc.) **Cannot be a relative of the student**
- * **Official** high school transcript (sealed)
